The session covers all elements of coercive control including an insight into the type of coercive control along with the effect on the victim, their families and loved ones. Coercive behaviour is an act or pattern of acts of assaults, threats, humiliation and intimidation or other abuse that is used to harm, punish, or frighten a victim.

The workshop is interactive, and the material delivered uses a variety of methods including real life case, videos, presentations, and exercises.

Parents/carers and students should, however, consider that coercive control is a sensitive topic, and they might find some of the content distressing.
